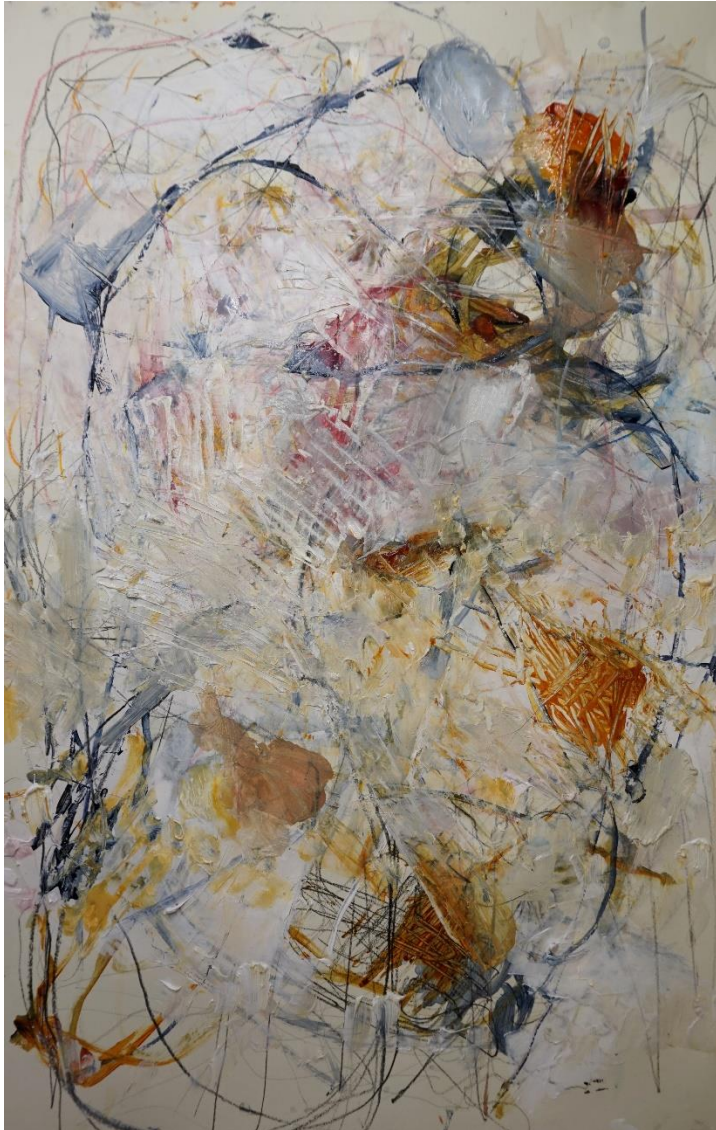


## Video 2- Abstract Painting

Video 3 – Plaster and hole fabric

#### Video 4 – Collage base

In this video I collage fabrics and papers to a stretched canvas to be used as a base for our projects.



Video 5 – Transfers and skins. These are beautiful additions we can add to our artwork. The skin is actually the printed image applying gel medium and peeling back the excess paper to create beautiful and mysterious translucent elements.



Video 6, 7 and 8– I show you how to draw a figure. I know part of it is hard to see so I added a line drawing that you can follow. Print it out on 11 x 17 paper.

You have the option of printing that and tracing it onto drawing paper and then follow along with the rendering of the figure. I added a grid so it makes it easier to do a line drawing

Print this out on 11 " x 17" paper









Video 9 and 10 – Now it's time to work on our collaged background to create a abstracted collage piece of art using the figure we just drew.



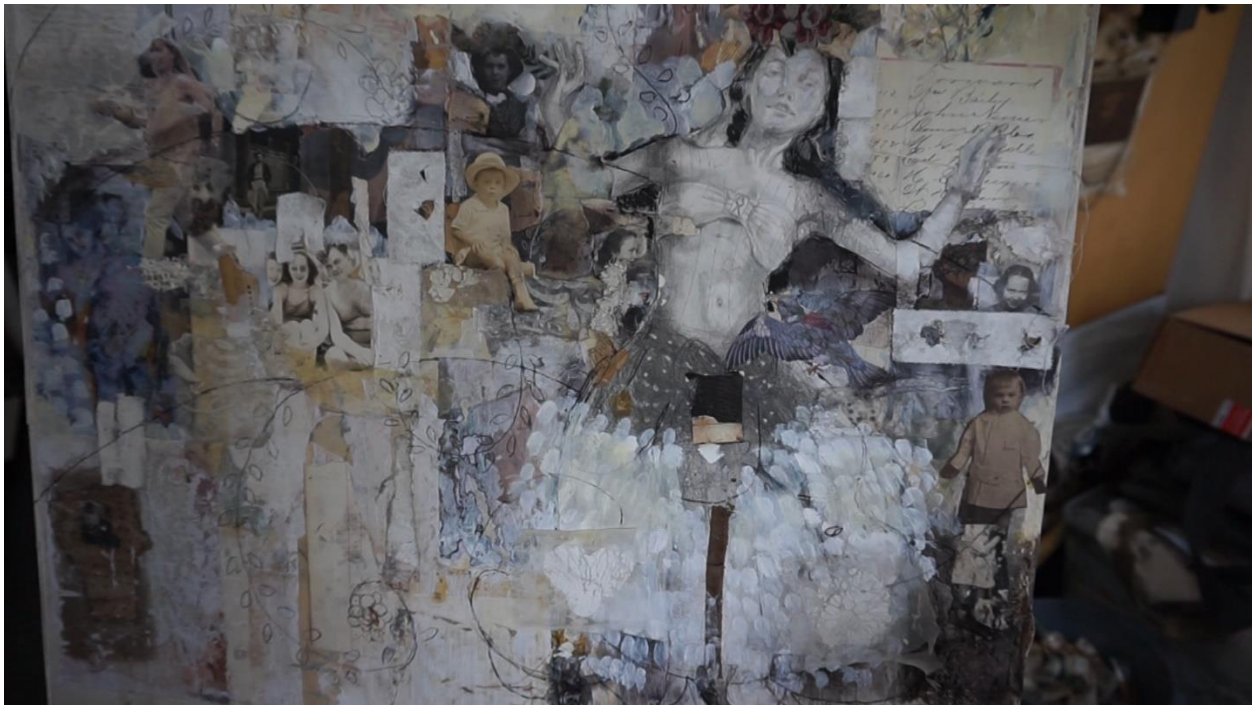
I added a layer of chaos with acrylic paints

This is a fun video. We do fast portraits in little squares. Then we attach them to plastered fabric and stitch them together

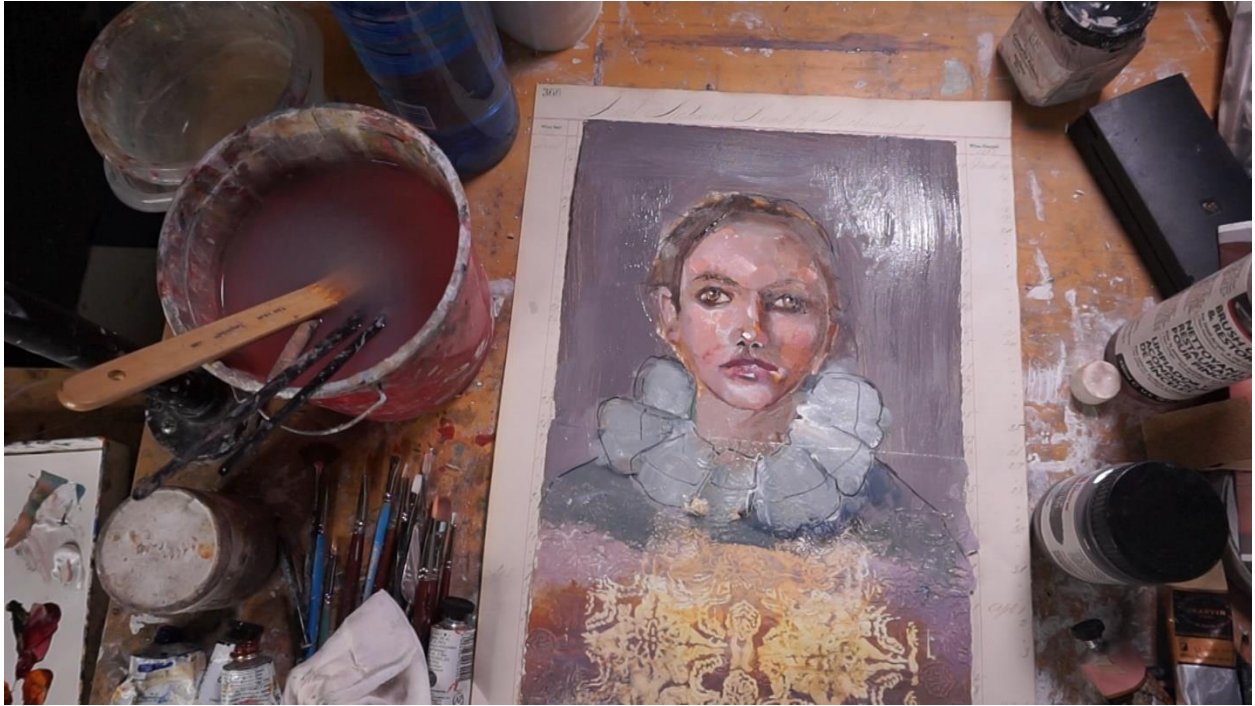




Videos 13-14 Plaster Stencils- these are my new stencils at Stencil Girl that I used. Here is a link to purchase these stencils
